4 1/2 ozs Gossling's Black Rum
4 1/2 ozs Gossling's Light Rum
4 1/2 ozs Gossling's Golden Rum
3 3/4 ozs Grenadine
28 1/2 ozs Unsweetened Pineapple Juice
15 ozs (Hood) O.J.
6 shakes of bitters

Pour all ingredients into a covered container and shake vigorously. I pour the mixture into "frozen" glasses.

Officer Voting


The voting for the 2000 Officers will be held on next month. Make sure to get your nominations and votes in.
