Recipe Corner

Angel Hair Pasta With Sea Scallops

1/2 cup soft breadcrumbs
 8 ounces angel hair pasta, uncooked
 1 tablespoon plus 1 teaspoon olive oil, divided
 1/2 cup chopped fresh parsley, divided
 1 clove garlic, minced
 1 teaspoon dried whole basil
 1/2 teaspoon dried whole oregano
 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour
 1/4 teaspoon pepper
 1 (8-ounce) bottle clam juice
 1 pound fresh sea scallops, cut into 1/2-inch pieces

Place breadcrumbs on a baking sheet. Bake at 375 deg for 5 minutes or until golden brown; set aside.

Cook pasta according to package directions, omitting salt and fat. Drain and rinse under cold running water; drain well. Place in a large bowl; set aside.

Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add 1/4 cup parsley and next 4 ingredients; sauté 1 minute. Add flour and pepper; cook 1 minute, stirring constantly with a whisk. Gradually add clam juice, stirring constantly. Cook 1 minute or until thickened, stirring constantly. Pour over pasta; toss well. Set aside, and keep warm

Heat remaining 1 teaspoon oil in skillet over medium heat; add scallops, and sauté 4 minutes or until scallops are done. Add to pasta mixture; toss gently. Sprinkle with toasted breadcrumbs and remaining parsley.

Serve immediately. 4 servings

There will be **prizes** and **games** for the kids.

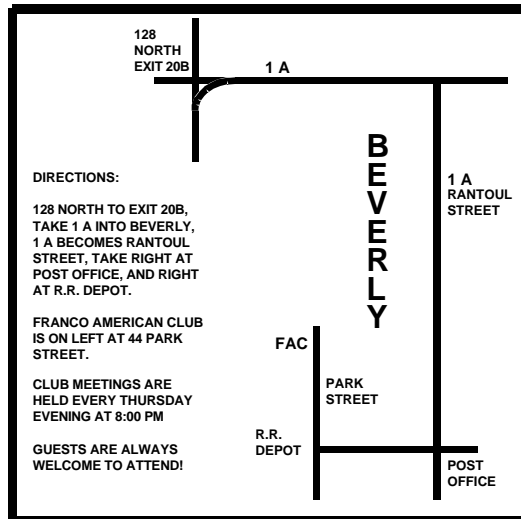
