Recipe Corner

Flaming Bananas

While you still have some black rum left from "Blowfishes Punch", try this:

6 medium ripe bananas
 2 tablespoons of butter
 1/2 cup lime or lemon juice
 1/2 cup of sugar
 1/2 cup black rum

Melt butter in a skillet. Add bananas cut in half lengthwise. Sauté over high heat until browned, turn once. NOTE: Sauté means "jump about"! Combine lime juice and sugar and pour over bananas. Cook about two minutes. Pour rum over mixture, remove from heat and flame. If you want, try and add 1/2 cups of raisins.

Serve a few slices of sharp cheese with this, enjoy.
