5/3 – Second Annual NSF Trivia Night

On May 3rd, the Froggies hosted a trivia night at Onion Town Grill as a follow up to last year's successful event, which was won singlehandedly by Jon Mulsman. This year there were 15 contestants, who divided themselves into 5 teams, and Vinny Egizi was the Trivia Master. The competition consisted of 4 rounds of general knowledge, literary, and science questions with increasing point value in each successive round. Several rounds had a bonus option to increase the point value for one question by 2x, 3x or 4x. In the 5th round, teams had the option to answer a question or complete a logic puzzle and were able to bet up to 100% of their points (essentially doubling their score). In the end, the winning team was "4-Square" (Ray P, Mary H, Linda P, and John C) with 100 points. "Brett



and Peter Awesome Team" rebounded from a 0 in the first round to place second with 90 points, and "Vinny's Dependents" took third place with 70 points (even after scoring a goose egg in round three). Fourth and fifth places went to teams "Turtle" and "MOSOB" respectively. Contestants each chipped in \$4 and cash prizes of 60%, 30%, and 10% of the collection was given to the first three teams.

Round 3


- Q: What is the atomic symbol for copper?


