Founded in the Fall of 1957, we are one of the oldest continuously active dive clubs in the world. Incorporated in 1958 we were featured in a double-page photo spread in LIFE magazine in 1959. We've been featured in Northeast Dive News and other publications.

As a club we promote safe, enjoyable diving. We dive year-round - starting on New Year's Day! Our activity schedule includes weekly club dives, night dives, ice dives, boat dives, and wreck dives. Also included are family weekend trips, club picnic and banquet, and winter dives.

For those who seek winter recreation without getting wet or lack dry suits, many of our members enjoy skiing as well. Skiing has grown to become an abiding passion for those seeking to keep fit year round.
