Thank you for your interest in our club. The North Shore Frogmen's Club, Inc., is a well established 501C non-profit club with nearly 100 members. We have membership levels for divers and non-divers alike who appreciate the water and we are affiliated with the Massachusetts Bay State Council of Divers. Our members meet weekly, participate in activities, perform charitable & community work, and of course dive together.

Founded in 1957, we are one of the oldest continuously active dive clubs in the world. Incorporated in 1958 we were featured in a double-page photo spread in LIFE magazine in 1959. We've been featured in Northeast Dive News and other publications.

As a club we promote safe enjoyable diving and give back to our communities near the water whenever we can. We dive year-round (starting on New Year's Day) and our members participate in weekend shore dives, night dives, ice dives, boat dives & wreck dives. We also promote family friendly activities, including picnics, dive trips, above water outdoor activities, dinner nights out, and our annual President's banquet.

As a member of the North Shore Frogmen, you will have access to divers of all interests and skill levels, as well as always having a buddy to dive with. Members are provided with our "BUDDY LIST", which enables members to easily contact each other to dive.

Some of our members enjoy traveling individually or together to remote destinations (tropics, Asia, Red Sea, etc.) for dive vacations throughout the year, individually and as groups.

Historically, our club has participated in community services that included search and rescue operations in support of area harbormasters, police and fire departments, and annual Earth Day cleanups (both in the water and along the beach).

The location and time of our weekly meetings varies, with the most current information found on our Website calendar. At these meetings we discuss "DIVE TALK", review our upcoming calendar of activities, and host presentations throughout the year by featured guest speakers. These presentations cover a wide range of subjects, including underwater photography, Marine Fisheries laws, lobstering, maritime history, and marine archaeology.

Members also share their own experiences with presentations about recent trips to exotic dive destinations. We even have "Movie Nights" where entertaining videos on dive related subjects are featured. Frequent raffles offer a chance to add to your gear bag.

Our members come from all walks of life; to join, you need only share our love and respect for the sea (and other waterways). Our members include beginning divers, sport divers, experienced divers, as well as several instructors and professional divers. Associate members (non-divers) need only have an interest and love of the water. You'll be diving with people considerate enough to help you suit-up, and patient enough to dive with you. Our members' experience will show you where the best dive sites are and help you perfect your diving skills.

Membership entitles you to our periodic newsletter: "Air Bubbles" with articles of timely interest to our members, including a summary of recent activities, featured speakers, dive tips, equipment reviews, reports on members' dive trips, and occasionally, even seafood recipes.
